

RULES AND REGULATION

At Shree Gurukulam, we maintain traditional values in a family atmosphere. Boarding life plays a vital role in the school and emotional well being of the students.

We have separate boarding house for boys and girls. Each child is under the supervision and care of a boarding housemaster or housemistress and is provided with modern amenities, superb bath and hot water facilities. We help the students develop individuality, interpersonal relationship, self confidence and self discipline,

- Hostel facilities are available for the pupils under the personal care and control of the Principal and Wardens.
- The hostellers will be allowed to go home only during school holidays with the permission of the Principal.
- Medical facilities are available for the hostellers whenever needed.
- The hostellers are strictly prohibited from keeping mobile phones with them.
- The inmates found involved in activities against the discipline of the hostel will be expelled at once.
- Compulsory study hours in morning and evening, Yoga (morning) and games (evening) recreation on Sundays are all provided with utmost care.
- Details of the hosteller's name, class, parent's / guardian's names, address and telephone numbers should be furnished to the Warden.
- Discipline, silence and proper study are strictly maintained by the inmates, during their stay in the hostel.
- In accordance with the proverb, "Cleanliness is next to Godliness", the hostellers are expected to keep their body, clothes and dormitories clean.
- Perfect silence should be maintained in the dining hall. Prayer must be performed before breakfast, lunch and dinner.
- The hostellers are expected to have their meals regularly, on time, without fail. Wasting of food is not encouraged. Those who do not take meals must inform the Warden immediately.
- If any hosteller is sick, he / she must immediately bring it to the notice of the Warden/Supervisor in the hostel.
- No hosteller can take leave without previous permission from the Principal or the Warden. They will be permitted to go home only with their parents / guardians.

- The inmates must return to the hostel on time. Late comers will be expelled from hostel if they do not give a proper reason for their late arrival. prior information should be given to the Principal in this regard.
- The hostellers are restricted not to converse with each other during study- hours. However, clarification of doubts regarding subjects can be made with the permission of the supervisor.
- Handling other's properties without their permission or any such disloyal activities are not allowed.
- Possession of valuable things or ornaments is prohibited strictly. For loss of any such properties, the management will not take any responsibility at any cost.
- The hostellers should not possess heavy cash with them during their stay in the hostel.
- The hostellers are permitted to go home during the first weekend of every month. Parents can visit the wards in the hostel during the third weekend.
- Visitors Day Time - 12.00 pm to 4.00 pm
- By no means, the parents are allowed to enter the hostel room.
- During the second and third weekends of the month, the hostel students can contact their parents over telephone time 5.00 p.m.
